Dear Ms. Dortch:

In Section XIV of Appendix A of the Commission's Order in the above-captioned proceeding,¹ the Commission directed Comcast to announce "the final locations of the five pilot communities" with which Comcast will partner to develop an On Demand and On Demand Online platform for public, educational, and governmental ("PEG") programming. Comcast hereby announces the following five pilot municipalities:

- The City of Fresno, California;
- The City of Hialeah, Florida;
- The Town of Peterborough, New Hampshire;
- The City of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; and
- The City of Houston, Texas.

Comcast is consulting with leaders in each of the trial municipalities to determine what programming (public access, educational, and/or governmental) would most benefit residents by being placed on video-on-demand ("VOD") and online. In accordance with Condition XIV.4.c(vii) of the *Order*, Comcast will provide a report to the Commission on the progress of VOD and online platform development, including the details of its activities in meeting the benchmarks established in the *Order*. Comcast will also post the information on its website.
